Tours in the planning stage are the Pike Place Market, the Museum of Flight and the LeMay – America's Car Museum.

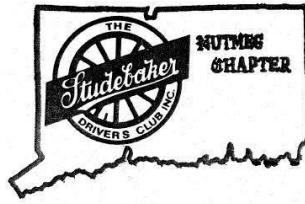

Philips Head Screw Removal - - The Easy Way - -

1 - Clean the socket of the screw face of all foreign matter such as dirt, paint, grease etc

2 - Select the right size and pattern of screwdriver. The wrong one will wreck the head of the screw for sure.

3 - Put a little coarse valve grinding compound mixed with oil on the tip of the screwdriver. This will give you a tremendous increase in the strength of the grip that the tip has on the screw head. You will find that you do not have to push as hard and turn nearly as hard on the screwdriver to keep it from riding up out of the screw head. You will be amazed at how easily you can unscrew even damaged Phillips screws.
